



### **Close of MOPAN survey**

The 2010 MOPAN survey was closed on Wednesday 2 June. From 6 April to 2 June, more than 700 respondents participated in the 2010 survey process that assessed the organisational effectiveness of the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the World Health Organisation (WHO), the International Fund for Agriculture and Development (IFAD) and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA). Respondents included both headquarter and country office staff of MOPAN members as well as direct partners of the organisations at country level. The survey was carried out in ten countries: Afghanistan, Benin, Colombia, Indonesia, Kenya, Nicaragua, Rwanda, Sri Lanka, Vietnam and Zambia.

Survey findings will be complemented with results from a review of policy documents of the multilateral organisations as well as with findings from other existing assessment processes (such as the OECD/DAC survey on monitoring the Paris Declaration and the Common Performance Assessment System (COMPAS) of the multilateral development banks).

Draft reports will be made available to the assessed organisations and to MOPAN member respondents for comment. Reports will be published in January 2011.
